

How to make a link to browser view in Zoom (not using the Zoom client)

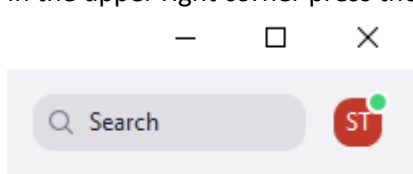
With standard Zoom settings a user cannot show Zoom in a browser if the Zoom clients already is installed!

If a user can show Zoom in a browser window and has a Chromecast connected to a TV, then the user can cast the zoom window to the TV for better view.

The person who set up a Zoom meeting must change the settings in Zoom. The participants cannot do that.

How to fix it?

1. Open the Zoom client.
2. In the upper right corner press the red bottom:



3. A menu opens.
Choose "Settings".
4. Settings open in a new front window.
At the bottom click on the link "View More Settings".
5. Then the settings open in a browser windows.
6. Login if necessary and go to the menu "In Meeting (Advanced)" under "Meeting".
7. Find the line: **Show a "Join from your browser" link**
8. Activated that option:



Now when this person makes a new meeting in Zoom and click on the link to the meeting (example):

Join Zoom Meeting
<https://dtudk.zoom.us/j/67927694332>

Then there is a **new link** at the bottom in the browser:

Having issues with Zoom Client? [Join from Your Browser](#)

Using the new link "**Join from Your Browser**", the Zoom meeting will open in a new tab in the Chrome browser.

The user can now cast the browser window to a Chromecast for bigger screen on a TV!

OBS: the new link goes to: <https://dtudk.zoom.us/wc/67927694332/start>
 instead of: <https://dtudk.zoom.us/j/67927694332>

So "j" is exchanged with "wc" (on Windows 10) and added "/start".
